“A new Maids’ Dormitory is now in process of construction. It is in the rear of College Hall beyond the kitchen and express entrances. It is to be a model building, equipped with all the conveniences, and connected with College Hall by means of an underground passageway. It will accommodate about fifty, and will make it unnecessary for any of the College Halls maids to live at the Barn.” – The Wellesley News: October 17, 1912

“In addition to these points of academic interest there are others that concern the general welfare of the College. Among them are the changes which affect the housing question....The establishment of the maids in the large new dormitory just finished for them has left much more space in College Hall for conference rooms.” – The Wellesley News: October 9, 1913
