Howe) owns a dwelling (occupied by Kilburn, \$2000) [44 Curve Street], a dwelling (occupied by Cahill, \$1400) [24 or 28 Howe Street], a dwelling (occupied by Varney, \$1500) [24 or 28 Howe Street], a barn & shop (\$550), 9 ³/₄ acres of land (Carhart, \$2250), ¹/₄ acre of land on Blossom Street (\$75), and 1 ¹/₄ acre of land (Flagg lot, \$100).
- Mortgage for \$1000 given by Albion K. Howe to Joseph H. Washburn on September 11, 1877 for site of 28 Howe Street.
