- 1905 Annual Town Report: Myrtie O. Taylor lives on Waban Street and owns (among other holdings) a store building (Fuller and Stevens, \$8000), a barn (Fuller and Stevens, \$300), a brick store building (\$30,000) [*Taylor Block*], a shop (\$2500), a barn (\$250), 8800 sq. ft. of land on Washington Street (corner, \$6800), 13,860 sq. ft. of land on Washington Street (\$7625), and 19,826 sq. ft. of land on Washington Street (Pope, \$5950).
- 1906 Annual Town Report: Myrtie O. Taylor lives on Waban Street and owns (among other holdings) a store building (Fuller and Stevens, \$8000), a barn (Fuller and Stevens, \$300), a brick store building (\$30,000) [*Taylor Block*], a new block (\$14,000) [*Norman Block*], a barn (Coolidge, \$250), 8800 sq. ft. of land (corner, F&S, \$6800), 16,930 sq. ft. of land (front, F & Pope, \$10,150), and 16,930 sq. ft. of land (rear, F & Pope, \$5075).
