### LINKS TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH

#### 1. A Sampling of Denton Road Educators, Past and Present

*The Misses Theoda Bush and Florence Johnson* (#32) were members of the Dana Hall faculty in the 1930-1950s. **Adele Lathrop** (#60) was Principal at Pine Manor Junior College for 17 years. **Denise Bacon** (#15) attended Dana Hall and Pine Manor Junior College and was later head of the music department for the schools; she also started the Dana Hall School of Music. Two former residents, **Rod Henry** (#58) and the late **John Agnew** (#66), were faculty members at Pine Manor. Current and former Wellesley College faculty members include **Doris Eyges** (#31); **Janet Giele** (#32); the late **Ella Bones** (#44); **Jens Kruse** (#48); **Alice Coburn Robinson** (formerly at #55); **Owen** ("Pete") and **Claire Zimmerman Stratton** (#55); **Alan Schechter** (formerly at #71); and **Owen Jander** and **Eugene Cox** (#72). Others have been associated with higher education outside of Wellesley: **Dodge Fernald** (#10), Harvard University; **Joel Slocum** (#29), an independent consultant on international education; **Janet Giele** (#32), Brandeis University; **Craig Latham** (#46), an independent educator and consultant in forensic psychology; and **Peter Weller** (#71), Harvard Medical School. A number of other public and private school teachers have also lived on the street: **Vivian Klein** (formerly at #24) and **Marilyn Dewar** (#19).
